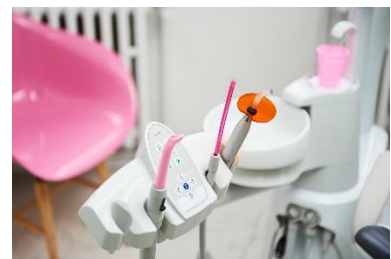

Advantages Provided by Our Clinic

Warm water:

all our dental procedures and instruments expose the client only to WARM WATER, producing a comfortable and pleasant experience; cool water can lead to discomfort and even a sensation of pain, especially in sensitive teeth!

Highest quality staff:

all our dental hygienists are members of the Association of Dental Hygienists of the Czech Republic, and take part in conferences, congresses and professional seminars all year round.

Easily accessible location:

our clinic's is exceptionally accessibility by bus, tram, metro or car. You can reach Floradent office without being exposed to the elements, either directly from the Flora metro station, or from the parking garage in the neighboring Atrium Flora shopping center. You can also park right on the street under our window, or, if you prefer, take a tram or bus right to our offices.

Services offered

A typical **dental hygiene** treatment involves the removal of soft coatings of plaque and hard deposits of tartar (calculus) using ultrasound technology and hand tools. We also remove pigment stains, most commonly caused by drinking coffee, tea, smoking, or ingesting other coloured foods and drinks by using the Air-Flow device.

Depuration - otherwise known as **tooth polishing**, is a prophylactic treatment done to render the teeth perfectly smooth and clean, thereby reducing the formation of new plaque containing harmful bacteria leading to decay.

A treatment session with one of our dental hygienists includes, as a matter of course, an individualized choice of appropriate dental aids, as well as the demonstration and practice of proper at-home oral-hygiene techniques.

Application of fluoride to the teeth reduces the risk of tooth decay and increases the resistance of the enamel to the acids produced by dental plaque bacteria. Fluoride treatment is carried out by applying dental trays filled with a fluoride product such as a paste, gel, foam or protective lacquer to the teeth. For especially effective tooth-decay prevention, we recommend a combination of fluoride and ozone therapy.

Tooth whitening is performed only in healthy teeth and gums that show no signs of decay or inflammation. We offer two different procedures: whitening carried out in the office using a modern Lightbridge bleach accelerator, and whitening carried out at the client's home using custom-made dental trays to be filled with whitening gel and applied to the teeth.

The treatment of periodontal disease involves the removal of all the harmful pathogens from the periodontal pockets with the help of special Gracey curette hand instruments and Newtron ultrasonic instruments for cleaning the surface of the roots of the teeth.

To quickly and reliably determine the presence of particular periodontal pathogens, we can take advantage of our on-site DNA periodontal pathogen test kit. The test uses samples gathered by endodontic probes, and the results provide important information regarding the severity of the periodontal infection, and also serve as the basis for creating an effective treatment plan.

The application of dental jewelry to the surface of the tooth involves placing an artificial sapphire or diamond on the desired tooth surface to create a luxurious smile.

Ozone therapy is a painless intervention that disinfects the oral cavity by destroying almost all known bacteria, viruses and other microorganisms. The application of ozone is characterized by the recognizable scent that we smell in the air after a typical summer thunderstorm (or on laundry left to dry outdoors). Ozone therapy helps to speed the healing of wounds as well as of herpes and canker sores, and reduces inflammation of the mouth. It is also used as an effective noninvasive treatment of cavities in tooth enamel.
